Special purpose acquisition company (SPAC) is a blank check company that raises capital from an initial public offering (IPO) before merging with an operating company. In 2020, there is more money raised and more companies listed through SPAC than traditional IPO. In Asia, Grab went public via a SPAC merger with close to \$40 billion valuations. Warren Buffet marked SPAC as a deal killer for his business. The US regulator has been calling for changes in disclosure and approval requirements for a SPAC merger. The popularity of this fund-raising vehicle has been rising very rapidly since last year and has attracted interest from institutional and retail investors, private and public companies, and regulators. How is this trend going to impact your existing and new business, your competition, and existing and future investors? The SPAC practitioners in this panel discussion will demystify some of these questions and share their views on the SPAC's future opportunities.
